

## Sample Public Service Announcements

**30-60 second spot:** You may be eligible to claim valuable tax credits worth thousands of dollars! If you work and have children, the federal Earned Income Tax Credit can mean up to \$5,751 for you and your family. If you paid for child care in order to work, more help is available through the federal Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit, which can be worth up to \$2,100. The Child Tax Credit can give families up to \$1,000 per child! These tax credits are more valuable than ever this year, so don't miss out.
