Families in Vermont:

Whether or not you owe income tax, you could get thousands of dollars in tax credits. You could qualify for:



Up to **\$2,100** from the federal Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit and up to **\$1,050** from the Vermont Low-Income Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit or up to **\$504** from the Vermont Tax Credit for Child and Dependent Care Expenses.



Up to **\$5,666** from the federal Earned Income Credit and up to **\$1,813** from the Vermont Earned Income Tax Credit.



Up to **\$1,000** per child from the federal Child Tax Credit.



Up to **\$800** from the Making Work Pay Credit, if you haven't already received it in your take-home pay.

***More families than ever are eligible for these credits this year.
To get these credits, you must file a tax return.***
