## **Families in Vermont:**

Whether or not you owe income tax, you could get thousands of dollars in tax credits. You could qualify for:

- Up to \$2,100 from the federal Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit and up to \$1,050 from the Vermont Low-Income Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit or up to \$504 from the Vermont Tax Credit for Child and Dependent Care Expenses.
- Up to \$5,666 from the federal Earned Income Credit and up to \$1,813 from the Vermont Earned Income Tax Credit.
- Up to \$1,000 per child from the federal Child Tax Credit.
- Up to \$800 from the Making Work Pay Credit, if you haven't already received it in your take-home pay.

More families than ever are eligible for these credits this year.

To get these credits, you must file a tax return.
