Noel León (she/her) is the Director of the Abortion Access Legal Defense Fund at the National Women's Law Center. Noel develops and runs all aspects of the Abortion Access LDF, which will launch in July 2023 to help cover legal expenses for individuals and organizations who have had an abortion or who helped someone obtain an abortion. Previously, Noel was an Associate at Emery Celli Brinckerhoff Abady Ward & Maazel LLP, where she represented plaintiffs in civil rights litigation in state and federal courts, and a judicial clerk on the U.S. District of Connecticut. In a previous stint with NWLC, Noel spearheaded a project developing legal resources for health

care providers facing discrimination and other employment barriers to providing abortion. She also served as a case manager for the DC Abortion Fund. Noel holds a B.A. from Yale University and a J.D. from the University of Pennsylvania Law School.
