


The National Women's Law Center's 2024 Gala







DEAR FRIENDS,



In just 10 short days, the polls will have closed on the East Coast. Vote counts will begin pouring in, reflecting not just who our next president will be, but how accessible abortion is across the country, how much our country's lowest-paid workers will make in five states, and so much more.

This year, this election, we are deciding what kind of nation we want to be. Not who we *are*, but who we will strive to become.

These are important questions—with life-changing consequences.

And yet, in spite of this uncertainty, I feel sturdy. Grounded. Ready.

Because here at the National Women's Law Center, we have been preparing for this moment. We are ready for whatever may come. No matter the scenario, we have a plan.

Over the last 52 years, we have worked across moments and movements to make real change for women and girls. Change you can feel in your wallet, in how you're treated at work, at school, and at a doctor's office.

Our roots are strong. With every new supporter, partner, and ally, we become stronger. Each year that we fight for gender justice, we grow more powerful than the last. And friends, we have been doing this work for more than a moment.

I am not afraid of the road ahead—whatever it may be—because I know what's behind us.

As author and activist James Baldwin once wrote: "Not everything that is faced can be changed; but nothing can be changed until it is faced."

This year at the National Women's Law Center, we've seen change—real change—in the lives of women and girls because we faced challenges head-on:

- * LGBTQI+ clients of ours who faced obstacle after obstacle accessing the health care services they needed to build their families reached a life-altering settlement. More LGBTQI+ people who hope to expand their families can now begin their journeys with the same access to fertility treatment coverage as heterosexual couples.
- * The Time's Up Legal Defense Fund, housed at the National Women's Law Center, supported a class action sex discrimination lawsuit on behalf of 34 women who were wrongfully dismissed from the FBI's agent training academy. These litigants successfully reached a settlement including both financial compensation and commitments from the Department of Justice to reform aspects of the FBI's training academy challenged as discriminatory.
- * **NWLC advocated for the confirmation of longtime labor law expert, Nicole Berner,** who was confirmed to serve on the Fourth Circuit, becoming the first openly LGBTQI+ person confirmed to that court and only the third openly LGBTQI+ woman to serve on the federal appellate bench.

We are witnessing the fruits of confronting the hard problems.

That's the Power of Us. Grounded in experience, rooted in equality for all, and ready for what's next.

There is more to do, but I am proud of what we have accomplished, together, and of who we have become. And I am prouder still of who we want to become.

And so, while we wait to see what unfolds over the next few weeks, I encourage you to take a breath. Reach for joy, and let it take hold.
